2012 GARBAGE/RECYCLING - PAYMENTS ARE DUE BY JUNE 30TH

Due to increases from the garbage haulers, the garbage/recycling fee is \$190.00 for 2012. Full payment is due by June 30. Payments after June 30 will be assessed a late fee of \$1.00 per month retroactive to January 1. Information is included with your tax statement. If not paid by Sept. 30 an assessment of \$202.00 will be on your tax statement. Please mail or drop off your payment at the Town Hall, include your parcel # on your check. If paying in cash please have the exact amount.

There are two different companies that handle the garbage/recycling. The recycling is done by Waste Management on a bi-weekly basis. The garbage is picked up by Nordic Waste on a weekly basis. Please call the town hall if you have any questions or concerns.

TOWN HALL RENTAL FEE & RESERVATIONS

Call 715 399-8385 for hall reservations and rules and go to the website to fill out the hall rental form. Hall rental is on a first come, first serve basis. You must prepay in order to have the hall available on the date you request.

Hall Rental with Kitchen – 1 Day - \$75.00

Hall Rental Only – 1 Day – \$50.00

The town has put in a park and ride area at the town hall site. A fence and improved lighting has been installed on the north side of the town hall property, please help save on gas and the environment by utilizing this new town improvement.

2012 DUST CONTROL

OPEN BOOK & BOARD OF REVIEW – What is the difference?

Please watch our website and town notices and newspaper for the dates for the Open Book and Board of Review. Open Book is what you first need to attend if you feel there is an error on your tax bill. This is your opportunity to meet with the assessor and discuss your tax statement issue. If you do not come to a resolution at the Open Book then you may make an appointment for a meeting at the Board of Review, at this time you need to provide documentation to help prove that your assessment is in error. The decision is then made by the Board of Review whether the assessment stands or should be adjusted. We will include more information about these very important meetings items on our website.

Please mail or drop off the enclosed form, your dog's rabies certificate, a check and self addressed stamped envelope so that we can mail the tag and your certificate back to you. Forms are also available on the website.
